



ENROLL YOUR CHILD CARE PROGRAM IN MCCYN-PLUS

The South Carolina Department of Social Services (SCDSS) has launched Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood-PLUS (MCCYN-PLUS), a program that offers fee assistance for military families. Here are the steps you can take to enroll your child care program in MCCYN-PLUS.

STEP 1: MEET ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

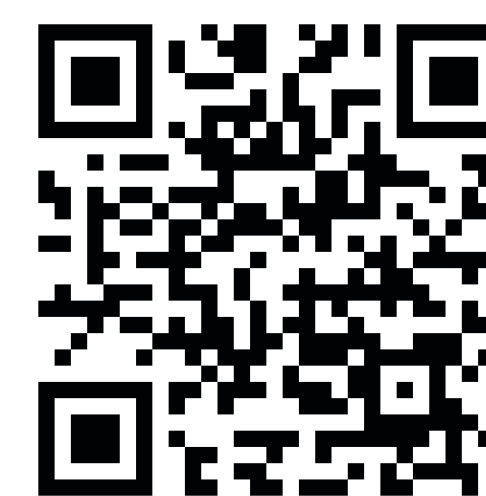
Providers interested in participating in MCCYN-PLUS must:

- Be a SCDSS-approved licensed child care program or family child care home
- Have verification of Child Care Licensing inspection from within the last 12 months
- Meet requirements of a DoD-approved national or state early learning accreditation agency

STEP 2: PARTICIPATE IN ABC QUALITY

Providers must participate and receive at least a B+ rating with ABC Quality, South Carolina's quality rating and improvement system. Providers interested in participating can go to [ABCQuality.org](https://www.abcquality.org) to find your county ABC Quality assessor.
